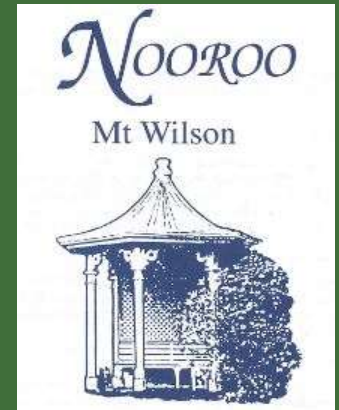


# Nooroo, Mt Wilson

We invite you to visit one of Australia's most magnificent gardens featuring over 11 acres of magnolia, cherry and other blossom trees, hostas, roses, clematis, bluebells, daffodils, rhododendrons, iris and rare examples of peonies, all in full bloom.

Located in Mt Wilson in the New South Wales Blue Mountains, and perfect for a day trip, Nooroo was built and planted in 1880 and original plantings include English oaks, chestnuts, ash and cedars.

2020 marks the 140<sup>th</sup> year of the garden.
